## LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

### SOUTHSEA ROWING REGATTA 12 JULY 2008

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the Queen's Harbour Master Portsmouth that the Southsea Rowing Regatta will take place at Eastney Beach, Southsea on Saturday 12 July 2008 between 0900 and 2100.
2. The racing will be confined to a rectangular area to the East of the Submerged Barrier, 1,000 yard in length running more or less parallel to the shore and extending to seaward by about 400 yards; the Eastern end of the course will be marked by a series of inflatable Red Buoys. During the Regatta there will be a maximum of 36 rowing boats on the water at any one time, up to 12 racing and up to 24 warming up for following races. Mariners are advised to keep well clear of the area while the Regatta is in progress to avoid hindering the Rowers on the Course.
3. For the duration of the Regatta, the 'Safe to Swim' zone highlighted in LNTM 27/07 and as marked by 4 inflatable Yellow Buoys in the immediate area of the Regatta will not be in use.
