LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

Maintenance Dredging - Trafalgar Wharf (Paulsgrove Lake)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the Queen's Harbour Master Portsmouth that maintenance dredging will commence in the approach channel to Trafalgar Wharf (Vosper Thornycroft Shipyard) from the 20th May 2009 and is expected to last for approximately six weeks which will be weather dependant.
2. The vessel conducting this task will be the "Witton II" (Backhoe Dredger) which will display the appropriate signals from the COLREGS when conducting her operations. Twice a day spoil from Witton II will be loaded into one of two self propelled barges "Split Two or Split Three" for disposal to the NAB Spoil Ground.
3. QHM Harbour Control will be informed of the vessels daily area of operations and may be contacted on VHF Ch 11 or by telephoning 02392 723689 for the latest information. Their movements will be de-conflicted from other movements by QHM Harbour Control in the usual manner.
