LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

Cross Solent Charity Swim - 6th June 2009

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the Queen's Harbour Master Portsmouth that a Cross Solent Charity Swim in aid of Portsmouth & Southsea Voluntary Lifeguards (PSVL) will take place at 1500 on Saturday 6 June 2009.
2. Five swimmers will be taking part in the event and each swimmer will be closely followed by a kayak. In addition, there will be four RIB's and a Mother Craft (Motor Vessel ARKWRIGHT) accompanying the swimmers and kayaks. The ARKWRIGHT will display the International Code 'ALPHA' Flag, whilst escorting the swimmers.
3. The proposed route of the swim is from Gilkicker Point to Ryde Sands to the west of Ryde Pier. The swimmers will be in one group starting at approximately 1500.
4. All mariners are requested to keep a good lookout and pass well clear of the swimmers and their support craft during their crossing of the Solent.
