LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

Hovercraft Survey - Portsmouth Harbour

1. NOTICE IS HERBY GIVEN by the Queens Harbour Master Portsmouth that on Thursday 25 June 2009 a hovercraft survey will commence on the mudflats around the North Easter part of the harbour. The purpose of the survey is to collect water and mud samples to monitor the Paulsgrove Landfill site, which will be weather dependant and could therefore, take up to three days to complete.
2. The vessel conducting this task will be a 4-6 metre hovercraft. Due to the way the hovercraft is operated, harbour speed limits will need to be exceeded and it may travel at up to 15kts. Work will be carried out predominantly during daylight hours and is planned to coincide with low water.
3. QHM Harbour Control will be kept informed of the vessels daily area of operations and may be contacted on VHF Ch 11 or by telephoning 02392723689 for the latest information.
